1. Mayor will promptly schedule and attend a meeting with senior Marriott officials. He will support labor's position. Mayor cannot guarantee that Marriott will make any changes in their position.
2. Mayor will bring together the general contractor and labor attempting to effect an agreement similar to the PetCo Park agreement.
3. Mayor commits to work with labor to appoint and encourage Council to confirm a person to the opening on the Convention Center Board that is acceptable to Labor and Mayor.
4. Labor will agree to promptly dismiss with prejudice their pending litigation challenging the Convention Center financing plan.
5. Labor will agree not to file any further litigation challenging any aspect of the Convention Center Expansion. Labor will agree not to support, financially or otherwise, any litigation brought by any third party and will agree to discourage challenges to the convention center expansion.
6. Labor will agree to write a letter to the Coastal Commission that unequivocally supports the Convention Center Expansion and work with Coastal staff as well as appear at the Coastal Commission hearing to state such support for the expansion.
7. Labor will attend the October 1 hearing at City Council and support the convention center expansion.
