Laborers International Union of North America, Local 185 appeals the Planning and Design Commission's June 28, 2018 decision for Project P18-014 on the following grounds:

- 1. An addendum is inappropriate for the Project. The Project and its environmental impacts have not been analyzed in a previous CEQA document.
- 2. The Addendum identifies a significant air quality impact from constriction-related NOx emissions, an impact that was not present when previous projects were analyzed under CEQA. As a result, at a minimum, a supplemental EIR is required to evaluate the new significant impact.
- 3. The Addendum's air quality analysis is not based on substantial evidence because of flaws in the air pollution modeling.
- 4. An EIR must be prepared because there is substantial evidence that the Project will have significant direct and cumulative air quality impacts.
- 5. The Addendum's health risk conclusions are not supported by substantial evidence. The Addendum concludes that the Project will have a less than significant health risk impact without conducting a quantitative construction or operational health risk assessment.
- 6. An EIR must be prepared because there is substantial evidence that the Project will result in significant increased cancer risk to nearby sensitive receptors.
- 7. The Addendum's greenhouse gas analysis and conclusion that the Project will not have a significant greenhouse gas impact are not supported by substantial evidence.
- 8. The Addendum's conclusions that the Project will not have a significant impact on biological resources is not supported by substantial evidence.
- 9. An EIR must be prepared because there is substantial evidence that the Project will have significant direct and cumulative impacts on biological resources.
- 10. The Addendum's conclusions that the Project will not have a significant impact on traffic is not supported by substantial evidence.
- 11. An EIR must be prepared because there is substantial evidence that the Project will have significant traffic impacts.
