Dear Mr. Szymanski, Ms. Lowe, and Ms. Malan:

I am writing on behalf of Supporters Alliance for Environmental Responsibility ("SAP/ER") regarding the Scripps Mercy Hospital Campus Project (Praject No. 658548; SCH No. 2021040374), including all actions related or referring to the proposed construction of two 15-story bospital towers totaling approximately 631,590 and 380,000 square feet respectively (Hospital I and Hospital II), a three-story Hospital Support Building with three levels of subterranean parking, a seven-story Medical Office Building with two levels of above-ground parking, an ambulahance drop-off area, a loading dock area, a central energy plant expansion, and utility yards, located on a 21.07-acte site north of Washington Street, south of development along Arbor Drive, west of Stafe Route 163 (SR 163) and Eighth Avenue, and east of Fourb Avenue, in the City of San Diego ("Project").

We hereby request that the City of San Diego ("City") send by electronic mail, if possible or U.S. mail to our firm at the address below nutice of any and all actions or hearings related to activities undertaken, authorized, approved, permitted, licensed, or certified by the City and any of six subdivisions, and/or supported, in whole or in part, through contracts, grants, subsidies, loans or other forms of assistance from the City, including, but not limited to the following:

- Notice of any public hearing in connection with the Project as required by California Planning and Zoning Law pursuant to Government Code Section 65091.
- Any and all notices prepared for the Project pursuant to the California Environmental Quality Act
 ("CEQA"), including, but not limited to:
 - · Notices of any public hearing held pursuant to CEQA.

- **D-1** Comments re-state a description of the project as provided in Chapter 3.0 of the EIR. No response is needed.
- D-2 Copies of all notices associated with the project have been sent to the commenter. Additionally, the commenter is included on the City's list of parties to receive any and all future public notices associated with the project. Last, all public notices pertaining to public hearings, CEQA documents, and project actions are also available on the City's website: https://www.sandiego.gov/city-clerk/officialdocs/public-notices.
